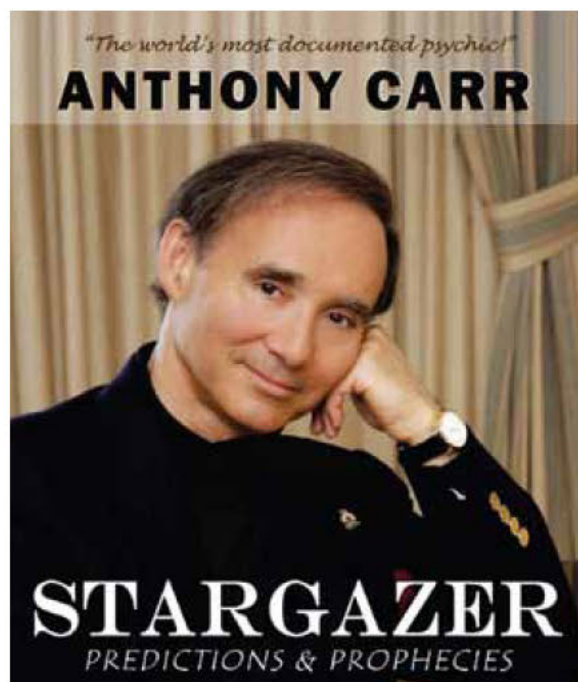

The singer was in Los Angeles to attend a pre-Grammys gala hosted at the Hilton by music executive Clive Davis, a longtime mentor who signed Houston to Arista Records for her self-titled debut in 1985.

Davis had mused about the possibility of Houston performing at the event, telling the Associated Press, "It's her favourite night of the year."
