

# MARILYN MONROE'S LOVING MESSAGE TO JOE DIMAGGIO

Renowned psychic contacts legendary movie goddess from beyond the grave...

**L**A TE legend Marilyn Monroe has sent a moving message from the beyond to ailing baseball great Joe DiMaggio: "I'm waiting for you in heaven, honey!"

That's the amazing disclosure of famed clairvoyant Anthony Carr after being commissioned to carry out a psychic investigation of a makeup chair used by the screen sexpot in her last movie *The Misfits*. In a world-exclusive GLOBE interview, the famed "seer to the stars" revealed he found himself in Marilyn's presence moments after

...sitting in the old wooden chair, which has a brass plaque on the back bearing her name. Carr says her message will be welcome news to cancer-stricken DiMaggio, 84. The heartbroken Hall of Famer reportedly never looked at another woman after his 1954 divorce from the screen goddess. "Seconds after I sat in the chair Marilyn appeared over my left shoulder wearing a beautiful flowing white gown," reveals Carr, whose celeb clients have included Richard Burton and Liv Ullman. "She looked absolutely fabulous and was happy and bright. More than anything she gave me a strong sense of DiMaggio and

let me know she loved him just as much as he loved her." DiMaggio recently spent 99 days in the hospital following lung cancer surgery and was given the last rites in December. But against all odds he bounced back and was watching TV when NBC mistakenly ran a bulletin announcing his death. The Yankee legend's marriage to Marilyn lasted just nine months, but he never forgot her. After the actress' death in 1962 he bought her a solid brass casket and a vase, which he lovingly filled with red roses for 20 years. The movie beauty had a string of lovers after divorcing DiMaggio and even married playwright Arthur Miller. But psychic Carr says: "Marilyn made it clear to me that DiMaggio was her one true love by repeatedly bringing him to my mind's eye." Carr is dubbed "the seer without peer" after predicting various events including the death of Princess Grace and the Gulf War. The psychic was commissioned by a memorabilia company, Big G's Collectibles, to investigate Marilyn's chair. It was purchased from the estate of her *Misfits* co-star, Clark Gable, and was delivered to a country house near Carr's Toronto home for his reading. A company spokesman says Carr was chosen after GLOBE chronicled his exploits. "After reading so many articles in GLOBE about him we were convinced we had found the right man. And his reading on Marilyn was amazing." — BOB BURNS
